Join the Webinar “Neuropsychology and the psychological care of persons with brain disorders” by George P. Prigatano, PhD, Professor Emeritus

Dr. Prigatano is the Emeritus Chairman of Clinical Neuropsychology at the Barrow Neurological Institute in Phoenix, Arizona. He is an internationally recognized expert in neuropsychological rehabilitation. His most recent professional work focuses both on the neuropsychological assessment and psychotherapy of adults and children with various brain disorders. He is also a pioneer in developing holistic neuropsychological rehabilitation programs for patients with brain injuries. He is an honorary member of several international organizations and in 1998 served as the President of the National Academy of Neuropsychology within the United States.

The administration of psychological care to persons with brain disorders requires a series of skills that integrate the knowledge of clinical neuropsychology with developmental psychology, psychotherapy, rehabilitation, and the study of the humanities. According to Prigatano, “This integrated approach provides a depth of understanding and a broader perspective that ultimately can improve their psychological care by reducing their psychological suffering and allowing them to engage life as lively as they can” (Prigatano, 2019, Preface). In the webinar, Dr. Prigatano describes his approach to this complex topic.
